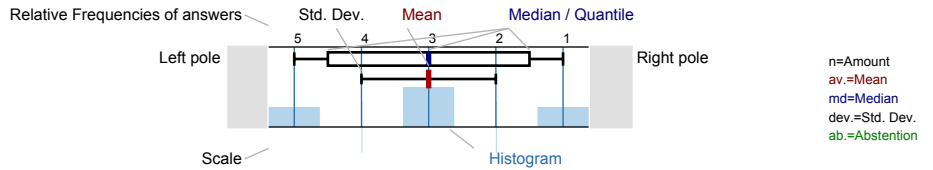

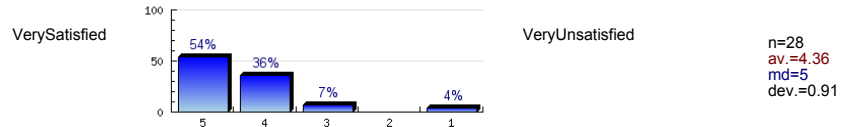

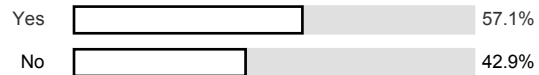

1.1) Please rate your satisfaction with the Library's willingness to involve faculty in developing its collections.



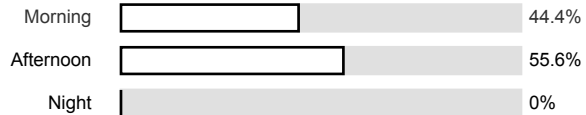
1.2) Do you use the physical space in the GCTC Library and Information Services locations?

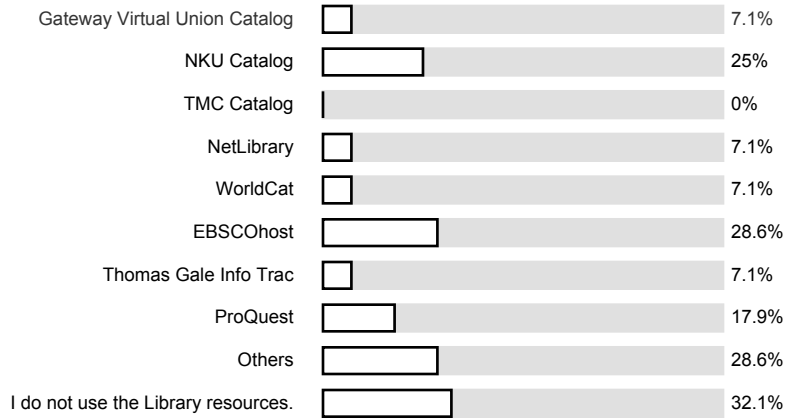

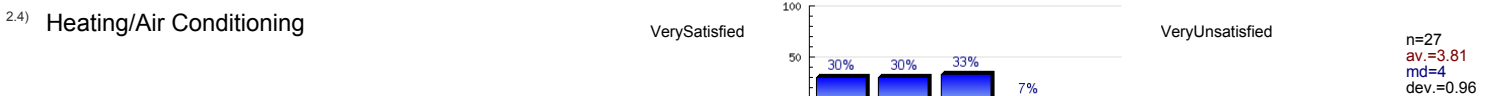

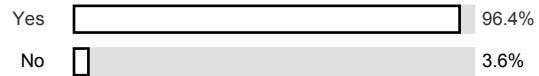

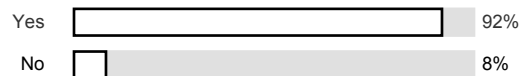

2.5) In your opinion, is the climate of the library appropriate for learning? n=28

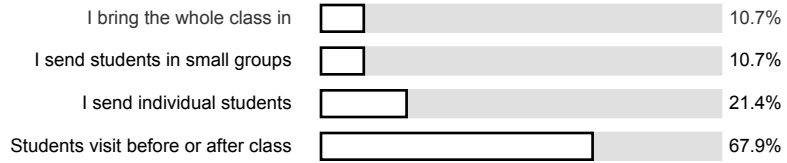


2.6) Is the library critical to learning in our institution? n=25

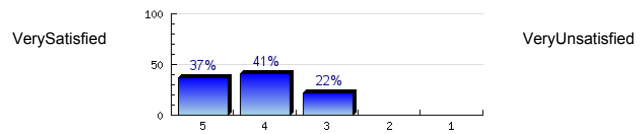

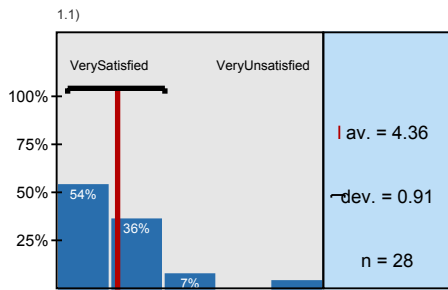

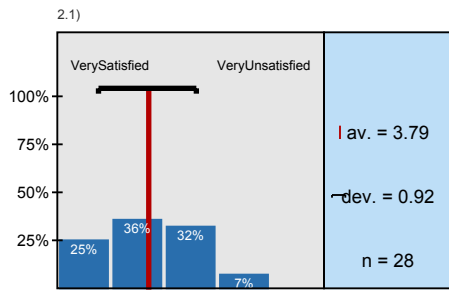

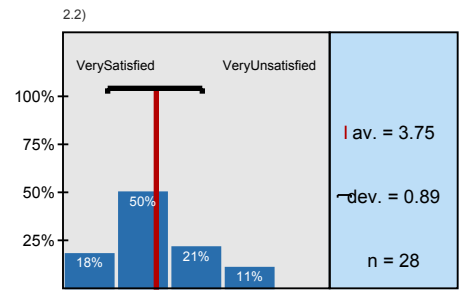
Histogram for scalar questions



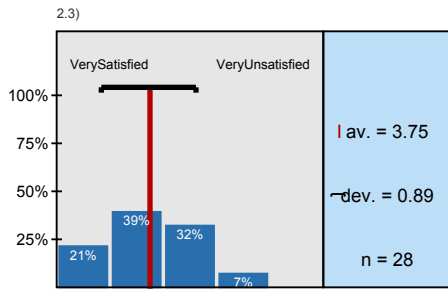

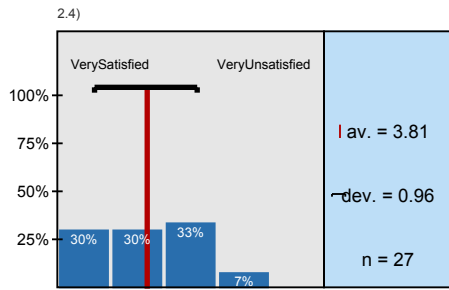

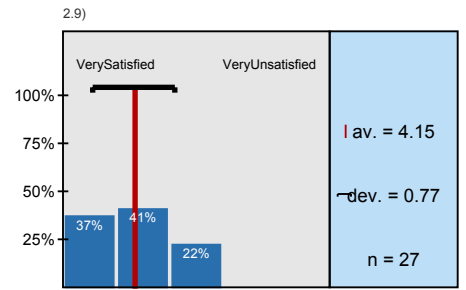
Number of computers and printers



Opening Hours



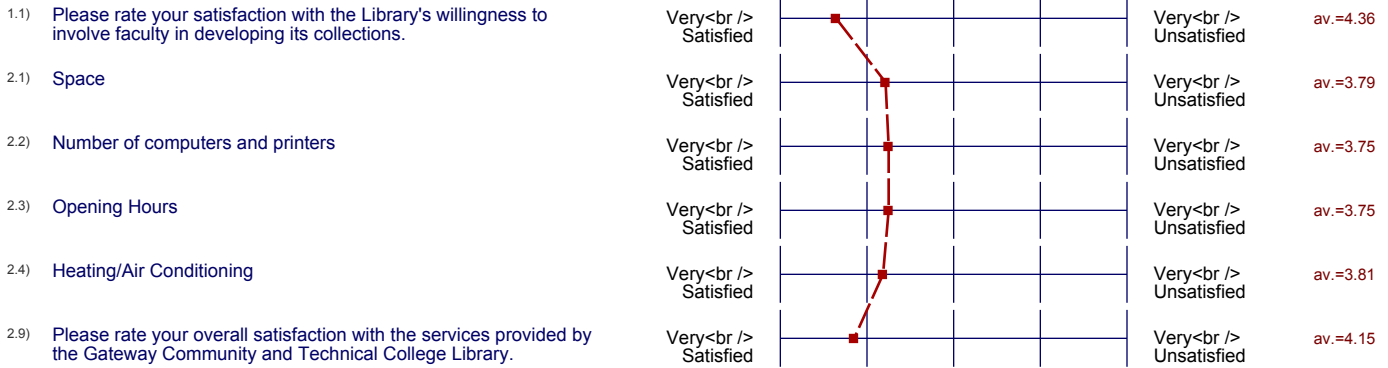
