Students Can Apply Early for Undergraduate Admission and Financial Aid

While the deadline for transfer admission for fall 2009 is not until August 1, 2009, (April 15 for Summer II) UK wants to encourage students that have not applied to submit their applications early. Students interested in applying for admission may submit their applications to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. All admission applications must be accompanied by an official high school transcript, an official college transcript, and a \$50 application fee.

The financial aid priority deadline for returning and transfer students was April 1st. However, Financial aid is still available for students that have not yet submitted their FAFSA form. Students need to be aware that some money has already been distributed to students that met the priority deadline, however, students that apply late may still be considered for grants, need-based scholarships, and loans. Please encourage students to act quickly on both admission and financial aid.

Trustees Scholarship

Tier 1: Currently enrolled KCTCS students that will earn their Associate's in Arts or Associate's in Science Degree with a 3.50 cumulative GPA after the spring 2009 term and then transfer to UK for the fall 2009 term are eligible to compete for a limited number of two year renewable awards which cover the difference between UK tuition and KCTCS tuition. A final transcript must be submitted along with this application documenting spring 2009 grades and the awarding of an Associate's in Arts or Associate's in Science Degree.

Tier 2: Currently enrolled KCTCS students with 48 hours after the spring 2009 semester (with at least 24 earned at KCTCS) and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.30, that are not receiving the above award, are eligible to compete for a limited number of \$4,000 scholarships, payable as \$2,000 per year for up to two years.

Tier 3: All other transfer students with a minimum 3.30 cumulative GPA, that are currently enrolled at an accredited institution and will have 24 hours by the end of the Spring 2009 term, are eligible to compete for a limited number of \$1,000 nonrenewable awards.

William C. Parker Scholarship

The William C. Parker Scholarship is a two-year renewable award, contingent upon full-time enrollment at the University of Kentucky and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or better and have completed a minimum of 24 credit hours during the 2008-2009 academic year. Applicants must submit a copy of college transcripts and a 500-word essay on how the student will contribute to diversity at UK.
