

Gateway Community and Technical College CLEP Exam Policy

College-Level Examination Program “CLEP”

The CLEP is a National program of credit-by-examination sponsored by the College Entrance Examination Board. These examinations may be taken at Gateway Community and Technical College. Credit may be earned through a) general and/or b) subject examinations. Gateway Community and Technical College students may earn a maximum of 45 credit hours from CLEP. The Gateway Community and Technical College is a recognized CLEP testing center and testing applicable to other institutions is also conducted.

CLEP exams are given Monday through Friday, (9 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.) and some Saturdays by appointment only.

The CLEP exam is administered electronically (on computer). You **MUST** contact our office to register to take an exam. Call (859) 442-1159 to schedule your date and time for testing. Examinations may not be repeated within six months of taking the exam.

The fee for a CLEP exam is \$72.00, payable by check, money order or credit card (American Express, Master Card or Visa) to CLEP. A separate fee to Gateway Community and Technical College of \$25.00 must be made by cash or credit card (Master Card, Visa, or Discover only) or check or money order. (Two separate accounts). **The payment to Gateway Community and Technical College must be made in ADVANCE and is non-refundable/non-transferable. This payment and form must be completed and received two days prior to your testing date. Forms can be completed by phone when using credit card.**

CLEP CREDIT

Gateway Community and Technical College will accept credit in these areas: Humanities, Natural Science, and Social Science-History. A maximum of 15 credit hours may be earned from these exams. This credit is awarded on a (P) pass basis.

SUBJECT EXAMINATIONS: COURSE CREDIT
